How to Use These Pages

Word Searches:

I have included 2 word searches: an easier and more challenging level depending on the needs of your child. The challenging word search has words that go *forward*, *backward*, *up*, *down*, and *diagonal*. The easier word search has words that are *forward*, *backward*, *up* and *down*.

<u>Scavenger Hunt:</u>

The scavenger hunt is an easy one to do in your own neighborhood or backyard. See how many of the items the kids can find. You can always take pictures and research the plants and animals you find.

Coloring Page:

The coloring page is just for fun OR you can have you little ones find certain items in the picture: the ladybug, bird singing, a bee, a squirrel, a bird flying, and flowers (count how many).

<u>Research:</u>

The plant study can be used to record flowers and trees your child finds on a scavenger hunt. You can also use it for further research about plants you find in the great outdoors. It is up to you.
