Line 1: 2 syllables

Line 4: 8 syllables
Line 5: 2 syllables (Synonyms
of line 1)

CINQUAIN #2

Line 1- 1 noun (the title)
Line 2- 2 adjectives
Line 3- 3 verbs ending in -ing
Line 4- 4 feeling words or a
phrase
Line 5- a synonym for the
noun in line 1

The first letter of the poem
spells out a word. Each line is
about the word.
