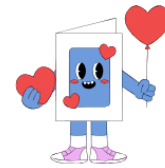


VALENTINE'S DAY WRITING PROMPTS

You find a Valentine's card that grants one wish. What do you wish for, and what happens next?

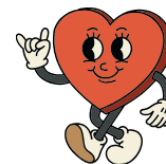
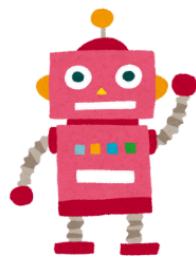


The Love Letter Delivery Owl: Imagine you're an owl who has to deliver Valentine's letters. What happens on your busiest night of the year?
